

“Notice under section 21(4) of the Building and Construction Industry Security of Payment Act 2009 (Tas).

In response to this Company’s Payment Claim dated _____ for \$ _____ your Company failed to provide a Payment Schedule within the time allowed by the Building and Construction Industry Security of Payment Act 2009 (Tas).

As a consequence your Company became liable to pay the whole amount of the claim on the due date. The whole amount has not been paid. Our Company has elected to apply for adjudication of the payment claim. Your Company has 5 business days in which to provide a Payment Schedule or pay the Payment Claim in full.

If, within that time, your Company fails to pay the whole amount, this Company will proceed to adjudication. If your Company also fails to provide a Payment Schedule, you may not lodge with the adjudicator a response to the adjudication application [see section 23(1) of the Act].”
