

Request for an Adjudication Certificate

Section 28Q of the Building and Construction Industry Security of Payment Act 2002 (Vic) ('the Act') refers to the issuance of an Adjudication Certificate if the Respondent fails to pay the whole or any part of the adjudicated amount.

Fees: The fee to issue an Adjudication Certificate is dependent on the adjudicated amount, as follows:

Adjudicated amount	Up to \$15 000	\$15 001 to \$40 000	\$40 001 to \$750 000	over \$750 000
Fee (inc GST)	\$110	\$330	\$550	\$825

The fee **must** accompany this request.

Adjudicate Today is requested to provide an adjudication certificate under Section 28Q of the Building and Construction Industry Security of Payment Act 2002 (Vic). Adjudicate Today is the Authorised Nominating Authority to whom the adjudication application was made.

Notes for the Guidance of Persons making a Request for an Adjudication Certificate

Section 1

- 1 The request must be lodged with the Authorised Nominating Authority which nominated the adjudicator.
- The request cannot be made if the payment claim, the subject of the adjudication, was served on the Respondent before 30 March 2007 ie; a payment claim subject to a contract formed before 30 March 2007.
- The request cannot be made before the expiration of both 5 business days after the Adjudicator's determination was served on the Respondent and the date (determined by the Adjudicator) as the date on which the progress payment became payable.
- The request cannot be made unless the whole or part of the adjudicated amount remains unpaid at the date of the request.
- The request must be accompanied by the fee charged by the Authorised Nominating Authority for issue of the adjudication certificate.
- 6 Completion of Sections 2 and 3 of the Application Form is optional.

Section 2

- 1 Interest **WILL NOT** be included in the adjudication certificate unless the Claimant completes Section 2.
- Interest must be calculated at the rate determined by the Adjudicator in the Adjudication Determination. Interest is simple interest unless the Adjudicator has determined otherwise.
- In calculating interest, the date upon which the progress payment became payable (as determined by the Adjudicator) should not be included but the date of this application should be included.
- Interest should be calculated only on unpaid amounts. If an amount has been paid, interest is not payable from the date upon which payment was received.
- 5 Don't calculate interest on adjudication fees.

Rate of interest under section 2 of the Penalty Interest Rates Act 1983

Calculating interest on amounts owing from 1 February 2010 to 6 October 2013:

Adjudicate Today understands that for amounts owing **from 1 February 2010 to 6 October 2013 inclusive**, the rate prescribed under section 2 of the Penalty Interest Rates Act 1983 is **10.5%**.

• Calculating interest on amounts owing from 7 October 2013 to 2 February 2014:

Adjudicate Today understands that for amounts owing **from 7 October 2013 to 2 February 2014 inclusive**, the rate prescribed under section 2 of the Penalty Interest Rates Act 1983 is **10%**.

<u>Calculating interest on amounts owing from 3 February 2014 to 10 August 2014</u>

Adjudicate Today understands that for amounts owing from **3 February 2014 to 10 August 2014**, the rate prescribed under section 2 of the Penalty Interest Rates Act 1983 is **11.5%**.

• Calculating interest on amounts owing from 11 August 2014 to 31 May 2015

Adjudicate Today understands that for amounts owing **from 11 August 2014 to 31 May 2015**, the rate prescribed under section 2 of the Penalty Interest Rates Act 1983 is **10.5%**.

<u>Calculating interest on amounts owing from 1 June 2015 to 31 January 2017</u>

Adjudicate Today understands that for amounts owing **from 1 June 2015 to 31 January 201**, the rate prescribed under section 2 of the Penalty Interest Rates Act 1983 is **9.5%**.

Calculating interest on amounts owing on and from 1 February 2017

Adjudicate Today understands that for amounts owing **on and from 31 January 2017**, the rate prescribed under section 2 of the Penalty Interest Rates Act 1983 is **10%**.

Relevant period	Interest Rate in accordance with section 2 of the Penalty Interest Rates Act 1983
1 February 2010 to 6 October 2013	10.5%
7 October 2013 to 2 February 2014	10%
3 February 2014 to 10 August 2014	11.5%
11 August 2014 to 31 May 2015	10.5%
1 June 2015 to 31 January 2017	9.5%
On and from 1 February 2017	10%

6 The formula which may be used to calculate simple interest payable is as follows:

I = A x <u>Days</u> x Rate of interest 365

Where:

I = Interest due

A = Adjudicated Amount as shown on the adjudication determination

Days = Number of full days which have elapsed since the due date for payment.

The due date for payment is shown on the adjudication determination.

EXAMPLE ONLY	Calculation	Interest due
If A = \$110,000 including any gst Days = 31 And Rate = 10%	then I = \$110,000 x <u>31</u> x 10% 365	I = \$934.25

^{*} Be sure to refer to points 1-6 of Section 2, when calculating interest.

Section 3

- If the Claimant has paid the Respondent's (or Claimant's) share (or part thereof) of the fees of the Adjudicator, the Claimant should complete Section 3 and provide the Authorised Nominating Authority with proof of payment.
- 2 Proof of payment may be by receipts, a statement by the Claimant's (or Respondent's) accountant, a statutory declaration or a statement by a person who is able to certify as to payment and non reimbursement.

Declaration

- The Claimant must complete the declaration at the foot of the Adjudication Certificate Application Form.

 If the Claimant is a company then an officer duly authorised by the company should complete the Application Form.
