VIC REVIEW OF ADJUDICATION

Notes for the guidance of the Claimant (Review Applicant)
 All documents **MUST** be attached to the review adjudication application form.

1. A review adjudication application can only be made if the adjudicated amount exceeds the higher of \$100,000 or the amount prescribed for the purposes of the section of the Act.
2. A Claimant may apply for a review of an adjudication determination only on the ground that the Adjudicator failed to take into account a relevant amount in making an adjudication determination because it was wrongly determined to be an excluded amount.
3. The review adjudication application must be made to the Authorised Nominating Authority to which the originating adjudication application was made.
4. The Claimant must make a review adjudication application within five (5) business days after the Respondent received a copy of the adjudication determination.
5. A review adjudication application **MUST**:
 - a. be in writing in the prescribed form (if any); and
 - b. contain the prescribed information (if any); and
 - c. be accompanied by Adjudicate Today's application fee of \$2,200.00.
6. A review adjudication application must contain the Claimant's submission in support of its application.
7. The Claimant must give a copy of the review adjudication application to the Respondent within one (1) business day after the application is made to Adjudicate Today.
8. The Respondent may make a submission to Adjudicate Today in response to the review adjudication application within three (3) business days after being given a copy of the review adjudication application.
